

CAMDEN COUNTY BAR FOUNDATION HON. RUDOLPH J. ROSSETTI MEMORIAL AWARD

Rudolph J. Rossetti was born and raised in Camden New Jersey and, although he started out in graduating vocational school an auto mechanic, he went on to Rutgers University and Rutgers law school in Camden. Following law school, he joined the Camden County Prosecutors office as an assistant prosecutor. He later founded his own very successful law firm, Rossetti and Rose. In 1975, he was appointed by the governor to the bench in Camden County. He presided over both civil and criminal cases for many years before becoming the presiding judge of civil and then assignment judge of Camden County. He worked very closely with the Chief Justice and was the driving force behind the development of differentiated case management which laid the foundation for how all cases in the state of New Jersey are now handled by the court. His brother Leonard and son Andrew are both practicing attorneys in Camden County.
